Civilians

- Civilians killed as a result of Russian aggression – **224**
- Lost civilians – **15**
- Injured civilians – **547**

Military Servicemen

- Servicemen killed as a result of Russian aggression – **161**
- Lost servicemen - **9**
- Injured servicemen – **947**

MIA Personnel

- MIA personnel killed as a result of Russian aggression – **11**
- Lost MIA personnel – **3**
- Injured MIA personnel – **227**

IDPs

- IDPs registered in the immediate aftermath of war – **127 000**
- IDPs who returned to their homes after the war – **100 000**
- IDPs who were not able to return to their homes after the war – **27 000**

Rehabilitation

- Houses built for IDPs – **3 963** (**110 698 625 GEL** spent)
- Flats in the renovated buildings given to IDPs – **1 500** (**19 923 754 GEL** spent)
- Houses purchased for IDPs - **453** (**8 281 491 GEL** spent)
- Houses and flats renovated in the so called buffer zones – **9 342** (**19 152 536 GEL** spent)
- Houses given to compensate the burnt ones - **415** (**10 333 500 GEL** spent)
